



Per Chapter 577 and 578 of Acts of 2019, the Maryland Parent Teacher Association (PTA) is required to submit the names of three qualified parents to the Governor for his appointment, with advice and consent of the Maryland Senate, to serve on the State Board of Education.

- Eligibility: Nominees must be a parent of a child enrolled in a Maryland public school.
- Note: Nominees are not required to be a member of any unit of the Parent Teacher Association (PTA).

#### **TIMELINE OF APPLICATION**

- Nov. 4 Nov. 15: Application process is open; deadline is Nov. 15 @ 11:59PM.
- Nov. 4 Nov. 15: Applications will be reviewed and ranked on a roll-in basis.
- ➤ Nov. 16 Nov. 19: Phone Interviews will be conducted based on highest ranked applicants only.
- Nov. 20: Highest ranked candidates will be recommended to the Maryland PTA Board of Directors (BOD).
- Nov. 23: Maryland PTA Board of Directors will determine candidates to recommend to the Governor.
- Nov. 25: Three names will be provided to the Governor for a recess appointment until Senate confirmation.
- ➤ Jan. 1: First day of appointment on the State Board of Education.

### STRUCTURE OF APPLICATION

There are six (6) central parts to the Maryland PTA application:

- 1. Contact Information and Core Essay
- 2. Content Area Questions
- 3. Acknowledgements and Understanding of Expectations, Duties, Mission and Positions
- 4. Short Answer
- 5. References
- 6. Interview Telephonic Availability

### LOGISTICS OF THE APPLICATION

- 1. Three (3) references are required. Please list name, e-mail, phone number and relationship.
- 2. List at least three days and times when it is best to have a phone interview.
- 3. A committee will read every application and evaluate applications.
- 4. Upon submission, you will be notified of receipt of the application.
- 5. All applicants will be informed on the status of their application after the Nov. 23 Fall BOD meeting.
